

Stanford 10 Achievement Test Battery

The Stanford 10 Achievement Test Battery is a norm referenced, multiple-choice assessment that will help educators find out what students know and are able to do. This is an optional assessment because it is not required of any student. Students may participate in the testing under the following conditions:

1. Students who intend to apply for academic year governor's school (Roanoke Valley Governor's School/Central Virginia Governor's School) must have updated achievement scores within the past three years of application. (A student's PSAT scores will also fulfill this requirement as long as the scores are available when the application is made.)
2. Students who are identified as gifted may need updated test scores if they intend to apply for regional and state summer governor's schools.
3. Students who are being referred for testing for eligibility for the gifted program must also have updated test scores. Those students will need to be referred through their school's gifted coordinator.

All ninth grade students received information in the mail regarding the Stanford 10 Testing. If you are a tenth grade student who did not take the test last year and are interested, please see Mrs. Belden, the JFHS guidance secretary for a "Permission to Test" form. All forms must be turned in by September 1, 2010.
